

## REPASO INTERROGATIVA

"Present Simple": (Hechos habituales en el presente, que ocurren con más o menos frecuencia)

"to be":	What	<b>am / are / is</b> + sujeto + (resto de la oración)?
"to have got":	When	<b>have / has</b> + sujeto + <b>got</b> + (resto de la oración)?
"can":	Why	<b>can</b> + sujeto + (resto de la oración)?
Otros verbos:	How	<b>do</b> + sujeto + <b>infinitivo</b> + (resto de la oración)?
	Where	<b>does</b> + sujeto (3ª persona singular) + <b>infinitivo</b> + (resto de la oración)?
	Who	

Ejemplo: My parents are from Madrid. Where are your parents from?

My cousins have got a new car. What have your cousins got?

Yes, she can play the piano. Can she play the piano?

Maria goes to the library on Monday. When does Maria go to the library?

- Yes, she is my sister. ....?
- He has got your book. ....?
- Susan usually plays tennis. ....?

"Present Continuous": (Describe algo que está ocurriendo en este momento)

What / Where ...	<b>am / are / is</b> + sujeto + (verbo) <b>ING</b> + (resto de la oración)?

Ejemplo: They are playing football in the garden. What are they doing in the garden?

- She is reading a book in the livingroom. ....?
- We are studying History. ....?

"Past Simple": (Algo pasado en el tiempo, ocurrido puntualmente en el pasado)

"to be":	What	<b>was / were</b> + sujeto + (resto de la oración)?
Otros verbos:	Where ...	<b>did</b> + sujeto + <b>infinitivo</b> + (resto de la oración)?

Ejemplo: I was at school. Where were you yesterday?

Pepe studied French for an exam. What did Pepe study?

- She bought the dress yesterday. ....?
- No, it was cold. ....?
- Pedro visited Maria last weekend. ....?

"Past Continuous": (Describe un proceso en el pasado, algo que estaba pasando)

What / Where ...	<b>was / were</b> + sujeto + (verbo) <b>ING</b> + (resto de la oración)?

Ejemplo: He was cooking when I saw him. What was he doing when you saw him?

- They were watching TV at eight. ....?
- Laura was visiting her grandmother. ....?

"Present Perfect": (Algo que empezó en el pasado pero que todavía tiene vigencia en el presente)

What / Where ...	<b>have / has</b> + sujeto + <b>participio pasado</b> + (resto de la oración)?

Ejemplo: I have lived in Málaga for twenty years. How long have you lived in Málaga?

- Yes, we have finished the exercises. ....?
- Michael has written two novels. ....?
- I have studied English for ten years. ....?
